- Meeting called to order at 7:09 pm.
- Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Linda/Krisanne made a motion to accept the March Minutes. Passed unanimously.
- The First Herbal Workshop at the Library was a vast success. Speaker (Christine Leo) was fantastic and the attendees were happy.
- Grant money should be arriving from the State Cultural Council.
