July 12, 2016

Motion to accept minutes of June 14, 2016 by F. Meyer and second. Passed by unanimous vote.

Motion to accept financial update pending review with town auditor by F. Meyer and second. Passed by unanimous vote.

E. Bazinet briefed the Commission on the status of the Common Monument refurbishment. It should start within two weeks.

Town Common signage, pictures and parameters were discussed and examples were displayed. E. Bazinet is collecting material to be considered.

2 West Main street demolition: nothing to report.

Progress is being made with the National Register Application. The meeting of property owners and representatives of Ma. Historical Commission (Betsy Friedberg) and Dudley Historical Commission last month at Black Tavern was reported by those commissioners in attendance to be very encouraging.

A motion stating the DHC supported Scenic Roads was made by M. Branniff and second. Passed with one abstention after a discussion concluded without adopting a definition of what constitutes a Scenic road.

A motion in support of trees received no second.

Local events for the remainder of the month were discussed.
