Historic District Project: Letters to the property owners within the proposed National Historic District have been mailed out yesterday. Representatives of the Dudley Historical Commission and The Massachusetts Historical Commission will be present to explain the ramifications of the proposed district and solicit the support of the property owners to the Dept. of the Interior for its submission.
