April 13, 2022

The scheduled meeting of the Dudley Conservation Commission was called to order on Wednesday, April 13, 2022, at 6:00 PM in Room 321A of the Dudley Municipal Complex by Vice Chairman, George Slingo.

Notice of Intent – Sawmill Rd, Jonathan & Jowita Androlewicz
 Jason Dubois from DC Engineering representing Jonathan Androlewicz. The proposed
 plan is to construct a driveway for a single-family residence within the 100' buffer zone
 to a boarding vegetated wetland and the riparian zone to a perennial stream. The lot is 28
 acres off Sawmill Rd. There is an existing car path now, proposed to turn it into a
 residential 14' wide paved driveway.

George Slingo open Public Hearing at 6:04 PM

Peter Jacobs from 91 Sawmill Rd asked if this property is zone for residential and if there is any intent to rezone to commercial. The commission clarify that driveway is proposed as residential use.

Francis Mikolajczak asked if this is before the stream that goes under the road. Jason confirmed that it is just before.

DEP issued a file number and comments on the project. The Commission saw no issue in the report.

Nancy makes a motion to approve and issue the standard order of conditions for Sawmill Rd as presented. Samantha Second. All in favor 5-0-1, the motion carries.

Nancy moved to issue an Order of Conditions to 55 Dudley Oxford Rd, Verizon Wireless. Samantha second. All in favor 6-0-0, motion carries.

- 3. Order of Conditions 40 Fish Rd, Jonathan Androlewicz.

 Nancy moved to issue a continuance for 40 Fish rd. Seconded by Samantha. All in favor 6-0-0, Unanimous.
- 4. Determination of Applicability Mason Rd, Town of Dudley Highway Department Emmett Lollis-Taylor from Tighe & Bond and Jeffery Murray, Highway Superintendent answered questions regarding the length and scope of the project on Mason Rd. The proposed project is to enhance pedestrian accommodation on Mason Rd. Part of the work is within the 100 feet buffer zone.

Matthew recommendations is to issue a Negative Determination with a waiver for work that would travers in the 25-foot zone.

Certificate of Compliance 15 Causeway Shores, Mark Stefanik Matthew recommended the issuance of a certificate of compliance to 15 Causeway Shores after his review of the site and completed Order of Conditions. Samantha moved to issue a Certificate of Compliance to 15 Causeway Shores, Mark Stefanik. Nancy Seconded. All in favor, 6-0-0. Unanimous.
