Meeting Minutes

July 27, 2022

The scheduled meeting of the Dudley Conservation Commission was called to order on Wednesday, July 27th, 2022, at 6:00 PM in Room 321A of the Dudley Municipal Complex by Chairman, Richard Androlewicz.

- 1. Request Determination of Applicability 438 Mason Rd, Omer Gadoury Matthew reviews the plans and suggest the commission issue a negative determination with two conditions.
 - 1. The existing beach cannot be expanded
 - 2. No sand can enter the water

Nancy Vajcovec makes a motion to issue a negative determination with two conditions; the beach not be expanded and no sand can enter the water, for 438 Mason Rd, Omer Gadoury. Samantha Costello Second. All in favor 6-0-0, unanimous.

- 2. Request Determination of Applicability 7 Indian Road, Dudley Landfill Solar LLC Rob Bukowski from Weston & Sampson gave clarification to Matt Marrow regarding the Storm Water Management. He also answered the commission question on how long construction will take. Estimated 4-6 months.
