

Important Information for your Medicare and Mass Health Standard Clients (65+)

In a typical year, Medicare patients can assess their health plans during the Medicare Annual Election Period (October 15 – December 7) and make changes for January 1. *This year is different!* One Medicare Advantage HMO plan in Massachusetts, Tufts Medicare Preferred HMO, has been awarded 5 out of 5 stars by Medicare. Eligible clients can now enroll in that plan any month throughout 2016. During the year, Medicare beneficiaries may find that their needs change. Some scenarios that may prompt them to consider switching health plans:

- Their present health plan is costing them more than anticipated, in premiums, deductibles, copays or co-insurance or does not cover needed benefits
- They are on a low premium plan with higher co-pays, but now require more medical services and would like to reduce their co-pays
- Their prescription needs have changed
- Their doctor now accepts Tufts Medicare Preferred HMO
