Thank You Dudley Voters

Three of five Proposition 2 1/2 questions that support the budgets of police, fire, our library and the Dudley-Charlton Regional School District were approved at the ballot box on August 17.

There were 32 possible funding outcomes based on the five menu-style questions. The approved questions will result in fully funding those budgets. Notices to rescind layoffs were issued August 18 for fire, police and library.

A balanced, supplemental budget that reflects the decisions made by voters at the polls will be presented at the October 16 Special Town Meeting.

Economic Development News



The Board of Selectmen has approved a 10-year lease agreement with Diamond Towers to install a Communications Tower on town-owned land off of Carroll Drive. The town will receive an \$100,000 initial payment and is expected to receive and additional \$20,000 in fiscal year 2024. This ongoing source of revenue includes a 50% share of subleases (companies installing equipment on the tower).
